Approval of the July 18 2023 Executive Committee Meeting Minutes

Treasurer's Report:

Treasurer Charlotte Hamilton gave her report orally stating that SCSA took in \$28,346.00, spent \$44,058.00, had \$124,000.00 in checking, and \$14,000.00 in the Strike account. Other than targets, there were no other major expenses.

There was some discussion about the bill for weed spraying.

Jerry will send a letter to Vaughn Cox advising him that the spraying was not authorized. That issue was tabled for more discussion and there were no more questions for the Treasurer, The Treasure's report was not filed since there was no hard copy on hand.

<u>Old Business</u>: **Indoor Range Committee:** Russ was asked by the committee to give a brief outline of what happened at the last meeting which he did.

Tom: talked about the 3D shoot on Eric's behalf. He said there was a good turnout that netted about \$5500.00.

Larry: said about \$15K to \$16K was taken in from match fees from the Western Regional shoot. He did not have his hard copy of details at hand, but he said that SCSA was "In the green" for that endeavor. He recited many of the impressive details as he could remember. He did note that SCSA took 2 trophies, many photographs were taken which will probably end up on the web site, and there was a .22 match on the hill on July 22.

Bruce Stevens: added that there were many positive comments about how impressive SCSA's facilities are.

Worth mentioning is the praise for all of the hard work of the volunteers without whom SCSA could not function as a vital and viable community asset.

Jerry: said the clay targets have been delivered and are in the warehouse, and the mower has been repaired.

Bob: praised Mark Burtis for his work on the pits and gave details of the particulars.

Kelly: Handed out a hard copy of the Candy shoot details from last month. Of note was one particular shot through a lifesaver at 100 yards. Those details are attached to the minutes.
