Approval of the April 18 2023 Executive Committee Meeting Minutes

Tracy Landeis moved to accept the minutes as presented by email with no comments and there was a second by Eric, Motion passed by unanimous vote. None opposed.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Charlotte Hamilton presented a profit and loss report.

\$160,401.15 in checking. She mentioned that the strike account was accumulating about \$7500.00. There were no further comments and the treasurer's report was filed as given.

Jerry: mentioned that Roger Roebbling passed away and had named SCSA as the beneficiary of his \$5,000.00 policy. Jerry will file the necessary paperwork to the insurance company and send thank you notes to the survivors.

Old Business: Indoor Range Committee: Since Bruce Edwards was not present until later in the meeting there was no report.

Cleanup Day Report: Most Directors had positive reports and Eric enumerated planned improvements to the Archery area.

Jerry noted that the Kubota mower needed some cosmetic work.

All in all, Cleanup day was a success.

Jerry: Said the new janitorial service will be Green Sky Cleaners.

Larry: said the grader will begin working tomorrow on the roads.

Jerry: asked about the computer upgrade and Russ and Eric explained what was happening with that.

Demo Day was discussed and details ironed out.

John Lundberg mentioned that the Apple seed program was May 6, 7 and gave details.

New Business:

Larry: mentioned that Dylan Mander from Weatherby requested permission to do a photo shoot on SCSA property and asked the Board's opinion. It was decided to let a 4 person volunteer group research, discuss, and offer the Board a solution before issuing permission for commercial entity use.

Ed: announced moving the regularly scheduled black powder shoot up a week.

Kathy: said W.O.T. will be using the clubhouse on Saturday.

Bruce Edwards: explained some rules involving the 501c3 issue.

Russ: said everything looked good in his department and reported the gate numbers.

Tom Bennett: said there will be no competition June 17 and 18.

Larry: Reports good weather for his events.

Tracy: said trap made money on Saturday and League will start on Sunday.

Eric: had their first 2 weeks of hunter's League which brought in \$155.00.

Ed: said there were 11 people at his April shoot.

Kelly: said the candy shoot and military shoot were still on track.

Kathy: said she had 7 shooters at her recent event and gave the details of planned events.

Bruce Stevens: said Silhouette was emerging from hibernation. No dates planned yet.

Bob: said he just completed giving the last CCW class which all went well and Bullseye League was over for the season. Listed all the other events.
